Food Bank Suggestions For January

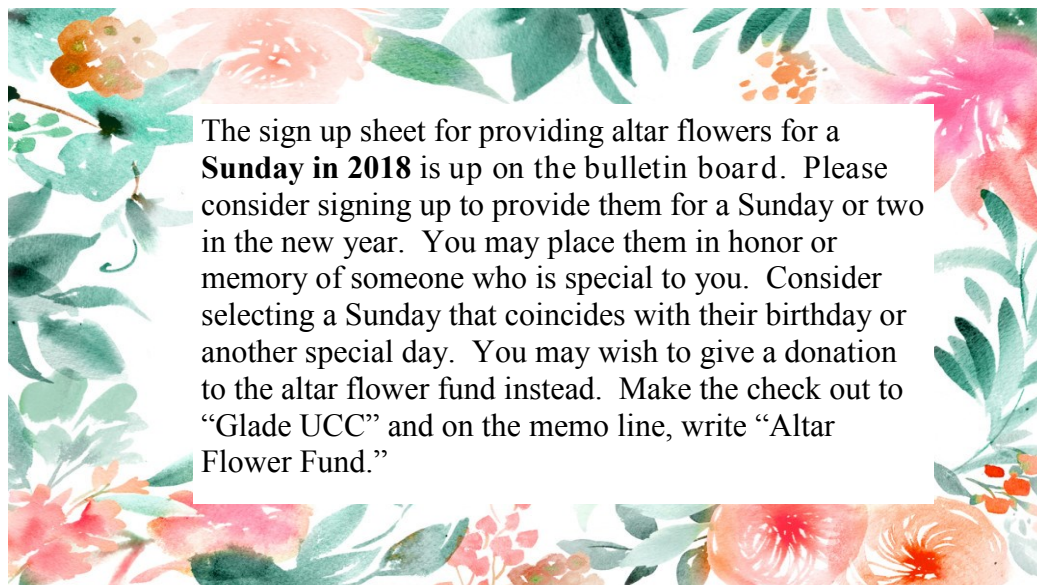
