As you plan your gardens for this summer, please remember the Food Bank. Fresh fruit and vegetables are always welcome and appreciated.





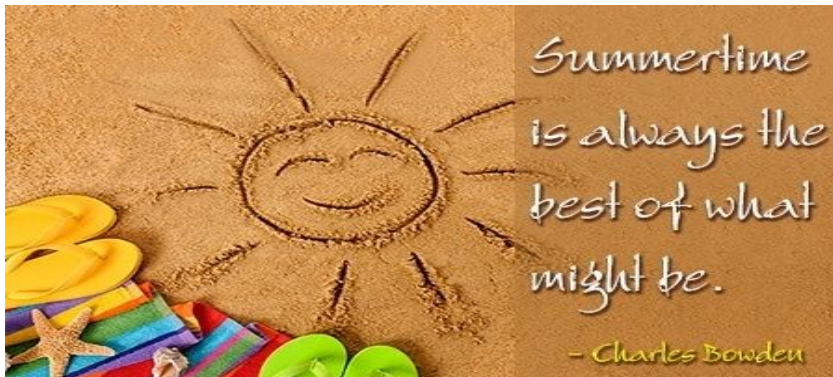
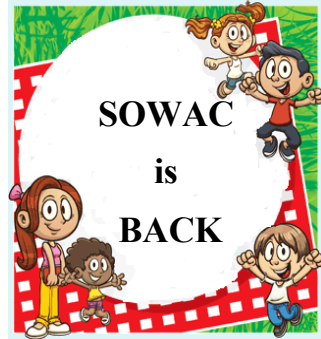

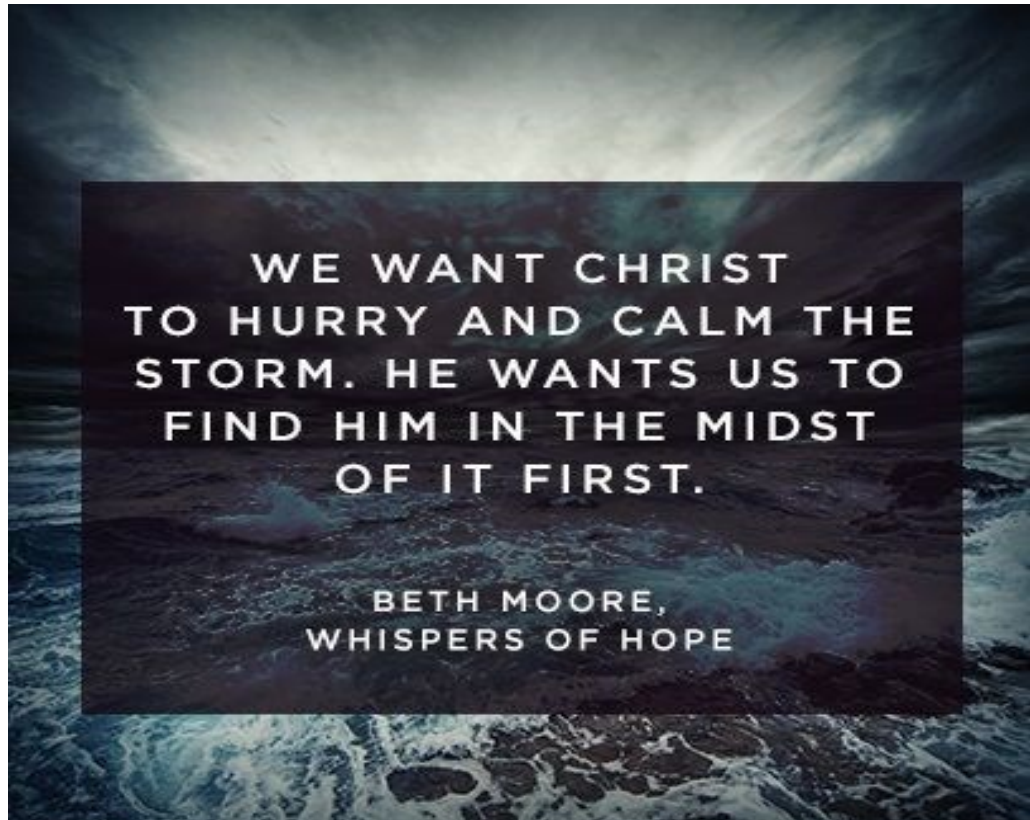
