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### **The Second Mile Recipient for June**

Meals on Wheels enables people to live independently at home through the provision of nutritious meals, personal contact and related services. A hot meal is delivered midday, accompanied by a cold meal that can be refrigerated and eaten later to ones that are homebound due to illness or physical limitations; not able to prepare meals and has no caregiver to assist with food shopping and preparation; or cannot safely prepare food due to physical, mental or emotional impairment.
