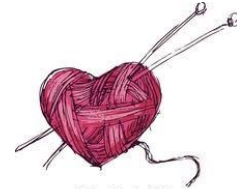


The flowers on the altar are in memory of Cassell “Skip“ Engel and are given by his family. He would have celebrated his birthday on September 28th.
