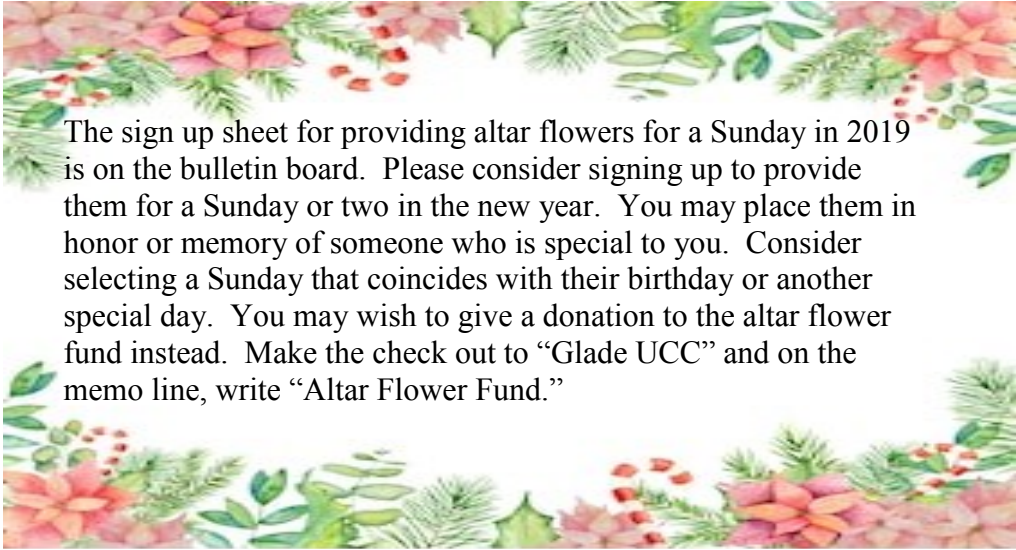

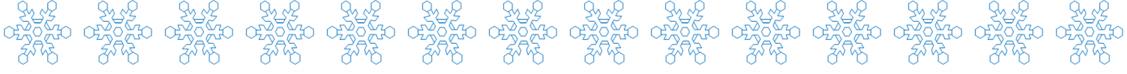
THE 2019 FREDERICK SCHOOL OF RELIGION *Learning for Life*

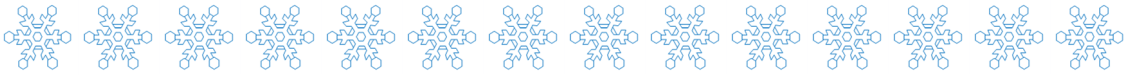


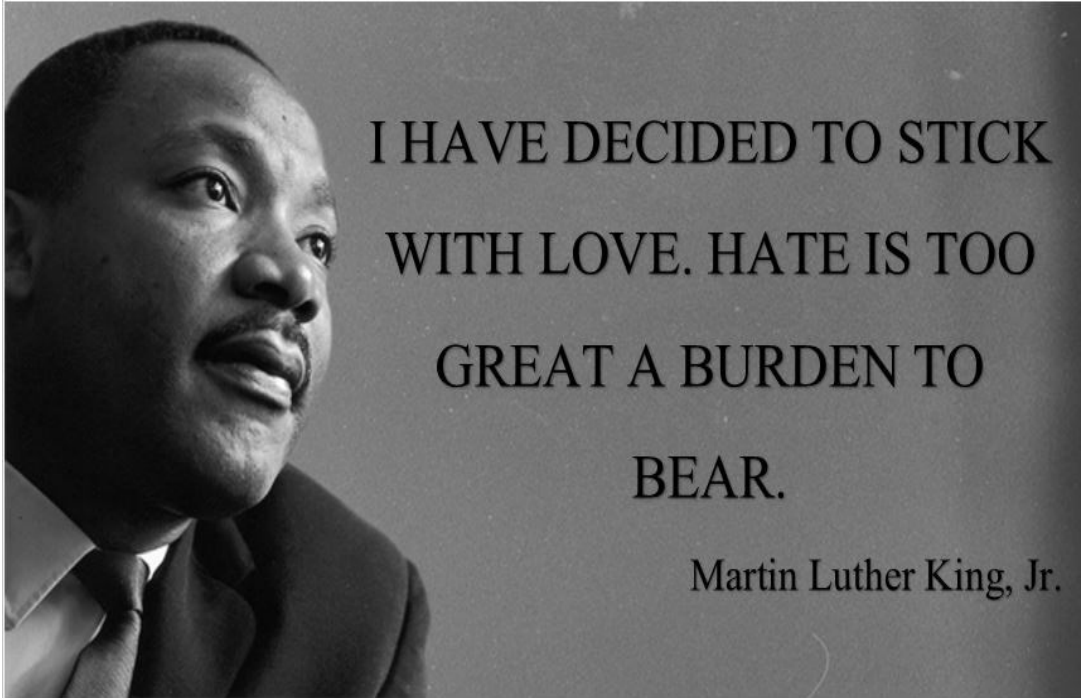
Inclement Weather Policy
