Items most in need are macaroni and cheese, cereal, peanut butter, tuna, canned fruit, canned pasta (like spaghetti-O's), spaghetti, and spaghetti sauce. Other ideas are boxed potatoes (mashed, scalloped, etc.), rice, canned peas, baked beans, and Hamburger Helper.

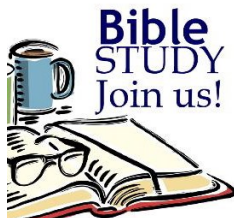

at 6:30 p.m.

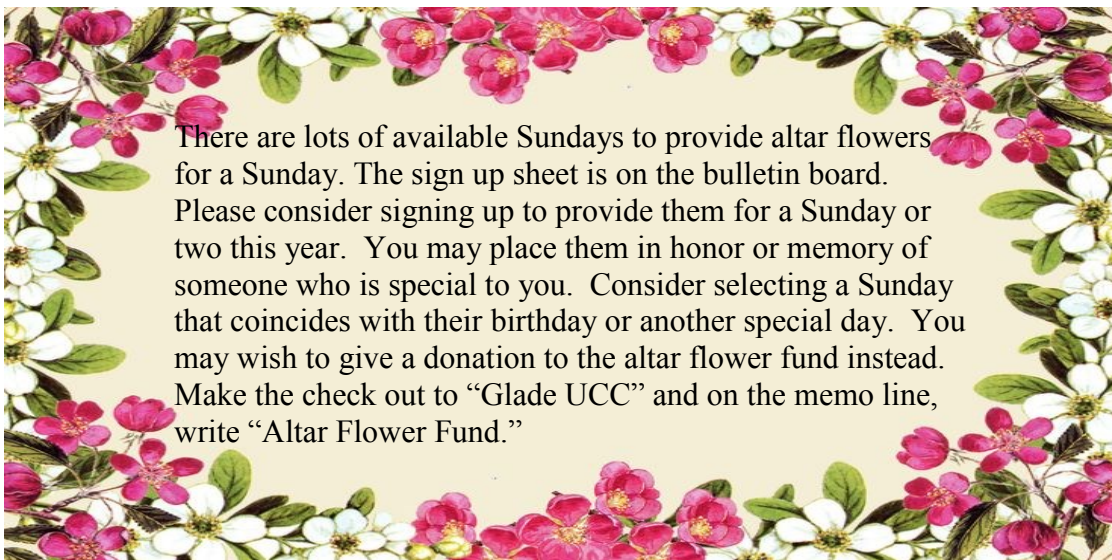
Join Pastor Guy every Thursday evening at 6:30 p.m. in the Social Hall for bible study.
