- The bulletin will be displayed on the screen, so there will be no printed bulletins available. If you would like a printed bulletin, please print at home and bring with you. The bulletin will be posted on the church's webpage and Facebook no later than Thursday's at 2:00 p.m.
- To limit exposure – services will be abbreviated, there will be no Time With Children, or nursery provided.
- The bibles and hymnals have been removed.
- There will be no singing. We will enjoy the beautiful piano & organ pieces that Bill Powell will be playing for us.
- Please exit the sanctuary as soon as the service is over, one row at a time beginning from the rear.
- Please no hugging or congregating before or after service. Go directly to your car, in a single file fashion and wave good bye.
- Should you travel to a “hotspot state” please do not attend church for two consecutive Sunday's following your return home.
