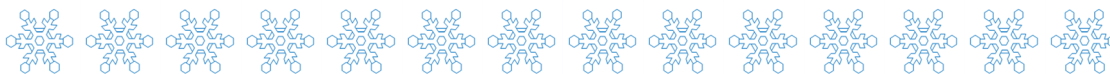
\$10 per ticket there will only be 1000 tickets sold.

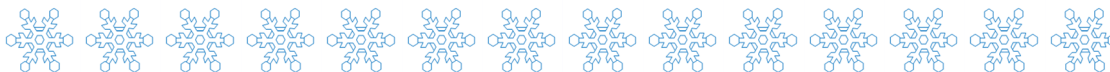


Inclement Weather Policy

Sunday School and morning services will be cancelled when the snow emergency plan is in effect at 8:00 a.m. in Frederick County.

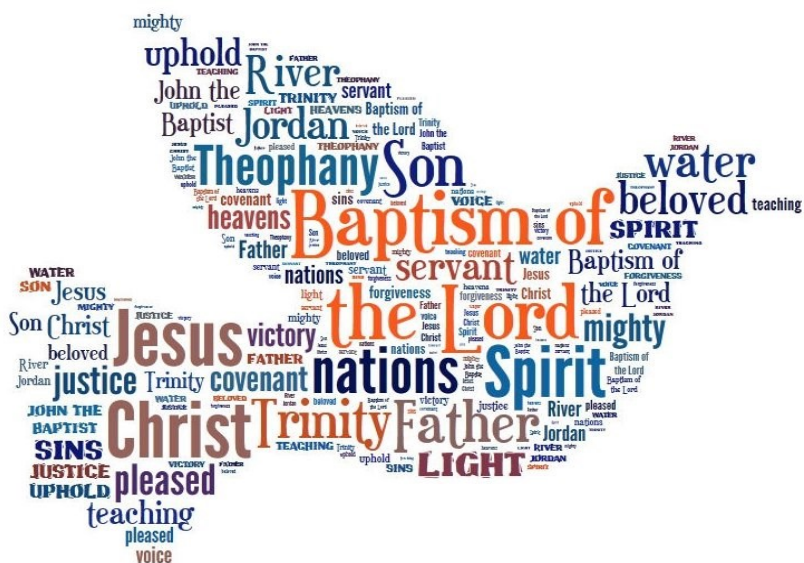
