**Lenten Bible Study Via Zoom**  
**Wednesday's February 24th—March 31st**



A Lenten Bible study via zoom with members of Jefferson UCC is being planned for Wednesday evenings from February 24<sup>th</sup> to March 31st. You can participate using your smartphone, tablet, computer, or phone line.

God's word is alive, with something new to say to all of us. That's why the Listen Up! Bible Study series does not simply teach information about the Bible. It listens to God speak. You will be encouraged to listen: listen to the Bible, listen to your own questions and responses, and listen to the honest sharing among participants in the study group. In that mix of biblical text, personal engagement, and honest speaking and listening, God's word may be heard, speaking challenge and comfort.

Our first Bible study will be on the book of Job. You may ask, "Why Job?" The story of Job is a thrilling, challenging, compelling account of the spiritual transformation that is possible when we find ourselves between the "falling apart" of the old world and the "building up" of the new, which is especially relevant in today's world. What Kafka said about a good book seems especially true of Job - that a good book should be like an icepick to break up the frozen sea within us. Reader beware: Job is an icepick of a book.
