One-third of NIN funds support the Council for American Indian Ministry (CAIM). Two-thirds of this offering is used by the UCC's Justice and Witness Ministries (JWM) to support a variety of justice initiatives, advocacy efforts, and direct service projects through grants.

Neighbors in Need grants are awarded to UCC churches and organizations doing justice work in their communities. These grants fund projects whose work ranges from direct service to community organizing and advocacy to address systemic injustice.

Poinsettia orders due Monday, November 7th



Don't forget to order your Christmas Poinsettia. Orders are due in the office no later than **Monday, November 7th**. There is an order form in the back of the latest issue of Glade Tidings on page 27, as well as on the back table in the sanctuary. You can mail or drop your order with payment off at the church office, or place in the box that is on the table in the back of the sanctuary.

The poinsettia's decorate our altar during the Christmas season, please consider placing one for your loved ones during this time.

The air conditioning units in the Sanctuary and Social Hall are at the end of their useful life and are failing. The congregation has voted to replace them with Heat Pumps that will cool as well as provide heat. This will allow us to use the oil fired steam boiler to provide only auxiliary heat for the Sanctuary, Social Hall and Kitchen areas. The total cost of installing 10 Mini Split

systems is \$101,365. We are receiving an 80% incentive from Potomac Edison through the Empower Maryland Fund of \$81,092. That leaves Glade with a cost of \$20,273 for the new units.
