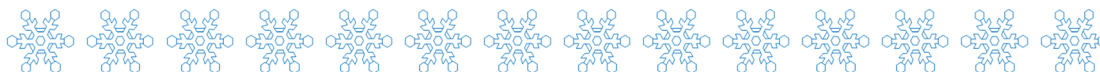

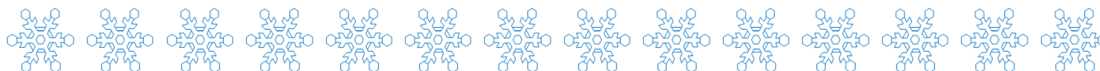
### **Inclement Weather Policy**
