Second Mile Recipient for June Meals on Wheels

Meals on Wheels enables people to live independently at home through the provision of nutritious meals, personal contact and related services. They provide two meals a day to eligible participants throughout Frederick County. A hot meal is delivered midday, accompanied by a cold meal that can be refrigerated and eaten later to ones who are homebound due to illness or physical limitations; not able to prepare meals and has no caregiver to assist with food shopping and preparation; or cannot safely prepare food due to physical, mental or emotional impairment. Your contribution to this month’s second mile giving will assist in providing a nutritional meal to our homebound.
