A hot meal is delivered midday, accompanied by a cold meal that can be refrigerated and eaten later to ones who are homebound due to illness or physical limitations; not able to prepare meals and has no caregiver to assist with food shopping and preparation; or cannot safely prepare food due to physical, mental or emotional impairment. Your contribution to this month's second mile giving will assist in providing a nutritional meal to our homebound.

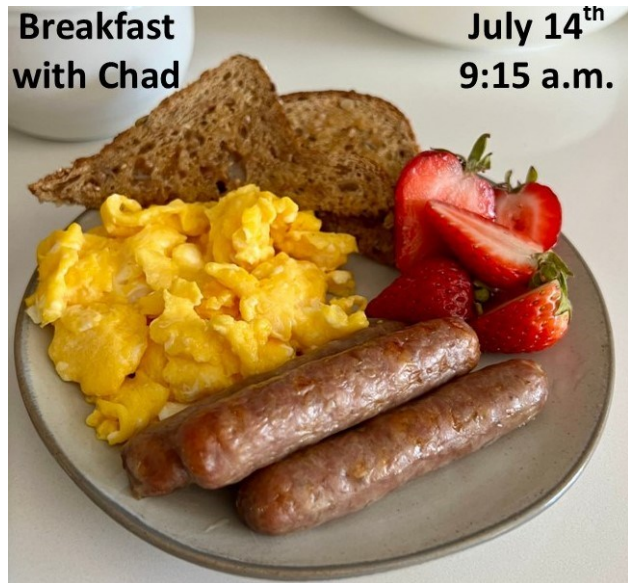
